Eligibility

All school musicians who have completed the *Seventh Grade* or above may apply for admission. All students must be recommended by their school music teachers.

Classes at All-State Music Camp

Piano Camp A flexible program of lessons, classes, and events to suit the needs of high school piano students. Studio classes, private lessons, and special interest classes such as improvisation, piano care, piano ensemble, and hymn-playing will be arranged so students may participate either solely in piano study, or combine piano with band or choir programs.

Audition/Contest Preparation An important class designed to help the student prepare for solo performance in music contests and in auditioning for All-State music groups.

Conducting Class Student conductors can contribute greatly to their high school music programs. This class includes basic stance, conducting plane, the various conducting patterns, preparatory beats, releases, and handling fermatas.

Improvisation Class A class for those who have already had at least one year of Jazz/Rock Workshop and are ready to explore the art of improvisation in more depth.

Beginning Band Want to have some fun? Sign up for this popular offering and experience the challenge of playing a different instrument!

Theory/Composition Learn the fundamentals of music theory and how they apply to music composition. This class is a practical, hands-on experience for the more advanced musician.

Choral Techniques A class designed for the serious student musicians wishing to improve their abilities as performing choral musicians. Limited pedagogical problems in the areas of production, diction, language, etc., will be explored.

Private Lessons Taught by artist-teachers.
